Here are the units to cover next year. We are starting with the lower year groups units of work for your class as this is a new scheme for the whole school. Please be aware that your older children in the class have additional skills and knowledge that will need to be incorporated into your lessons. You can find these in the final column.

Please also ensure you plan an additional one or two lessons for the children to use what they have learnt to create their own piece of work linked to your topic.

Celebrating and evaluating their work is also very important and I would like you to plan in a big end of unit 'gallery' for other classes/parents/the community to see and enjoy! Each class needs to have at least one of these events every year.

Year 1/2	<u>Term 1</u> Y1 unit: Drawing	<u>Drawing overview:</u> Exploring mark-making and line; working and experimenting with different materials through observational and collaborative pieces.	<u>Drawing skills Y2</u> Experiment with drawing on different surfaces and begin to explore tone using a variety of pencil grades (HB, 2B, 4B) to show form, drawing light/dark lines, patterns and shapes. Talk about art they have seen using some appropriate subject vocabulary. Be able to make links between pieces of art. Explain their ideas and opinions about their own and other's artwork, giving reasons. Be able to talk about how they could improve their own work.
	<u>Term 2</u> Y1 Unit: Painting and Mixed Media	<u>Painting overview:</u> Exploring colour mixing through paint play, using a range of tools to paint on different surfaces and creating paintings inspired by Clarice Cliff and Jasper Johns.	

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	<u>Term 3</u> Year 1 unit: Sculpture and 3D	<u>Sculpture and Mixed Media overview:</u> Creating simple three dimensional shapes and structures using familiar materials, children develop skills in manipulating paper and card. They fold, roll and scrunch materials to make their own sculptures.	
Year 2/3	<u>Year 2 Unit</u> Drawing	Using storybook illustration as a stimulus, children develop their mark-making to explore a wider range of tools and experiment with creating texture to add detail to drawings.	<u>Drawing skills Y3</u> generate ideas from a range of stimuli and carry out simple research and evaluation as part of the making process Use sketchbook for a wider range of uses for example recording things using drawings and annotation, planning and taking next steps in a making process Draw with expression and begin to experiment with gestural and quick sketching Developing drawing through further direct observation, using tonal shading and starting to apply an understanding of shape to communicate form and proportion. Use their own experiences to explain how art works may have been made. Use sketchbooks as part of the problem solving process and making changes to improve their work

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	<u>Year 2 Unit</u> Craft and Design	Responding to a design brief, children learn three techniques for working creatively with materials and at the end of the project, evaluate their design ideas.	
	<u>Year 2 Unit</u> Sculpture and 3D (Clay)	Exploring the way clay can be shaped and joined, children learn a range of essential skills for working with this medium. They learn about the sculpture of Rachel Whiteread and create their own clay house tile in response.	
Year 3/4	<u>Year 3 unit</u> Drawing	Developing an understanding of shading and drawing techniques to create botanical inspired drawings.	<u>Drawing skills Y4</u> Plan more purposefully for an outcome Demonstrate beginnings of an individual style Use growing knowledge of different drawing materials, combining media for effect Develop more intricate mark making More complex vocabulary when discussing their own and others' work Evaluate their work more regularly.
	<u>Year 3 unit</u> Painting and mixed media	Discovering how and why our ancient ancestors made art, experimenting with natural materials to make homemade paints and playing with scale to paint on a range of surfaces.	

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	<u>Year 3 unit</u> Craft and Design	Developing design and craft skills taking inspiration from Ancient Egyptian art and pattern and paper making.	
Year 5/6	<u>Year 5 unit</u> <u>Drawing</u> Not available until 30 th Sept 2022	Developing ideas more independently, pupils consider the purpose of drawings as they investigate how imagery was used in the 'Space race' that began in the 1950s. They combine collage and printmaking to create a piece in their own style.	<u>Drawing skills Y6</u> Develop their own starting points for creative outcomes Draw expressively in their own personal style and in response to their choice of stimulus Mastery of materials and techniques Explore new surfaces, e.g. clay, layering media and incorporating digital drawing techniques give reasoned evaluations of their own and others' which takes account of context and intention
	<u>Year 5 unit</u> Painting and mixed media	Investigating self-portraits by a range of artists, children use photographs of themselves as a starting point for developing their own unique self-portraits in mixed-media.	
	<u>Year 5 unit</u> Craft and Design	Investigating the built environment, drawing from observation, evaluating design features of buildings and developing ideas to create individual architectural designs
