RSHE non-negotiables

Lesson resources:

Jigsaw Journal:

- Jigsaw Journey sheet stuck into books at the beginning of each new Puzzle (unit of work). (KS2)
- Jigsaw Learning sheet stuck into books at the beginning of each piece (lesson). (KS1)
- Short date.
- Evidence of work ticked or stamped.
- Evidence of green pen corrections for HFW and key vocabulary.
- Seesaw sticker for any work put onto Seesaw.

Assessment:

- Jigsaw Journey/Learning sheet coloured in at the end of each lesson.
- The last piece (lesson) to be used as summative assessment.

RSHE Learning Model (lesson structure)

Start of lesson

1. Class sat in a circle (on chairs) ready to start 'Connect us'
2. Share 'The Jigsaw Charter' with the children to reinforce how we work together.

Calm me.

Open my mind.

Tell me or show me.

Let me learn.

Help me reflect
