



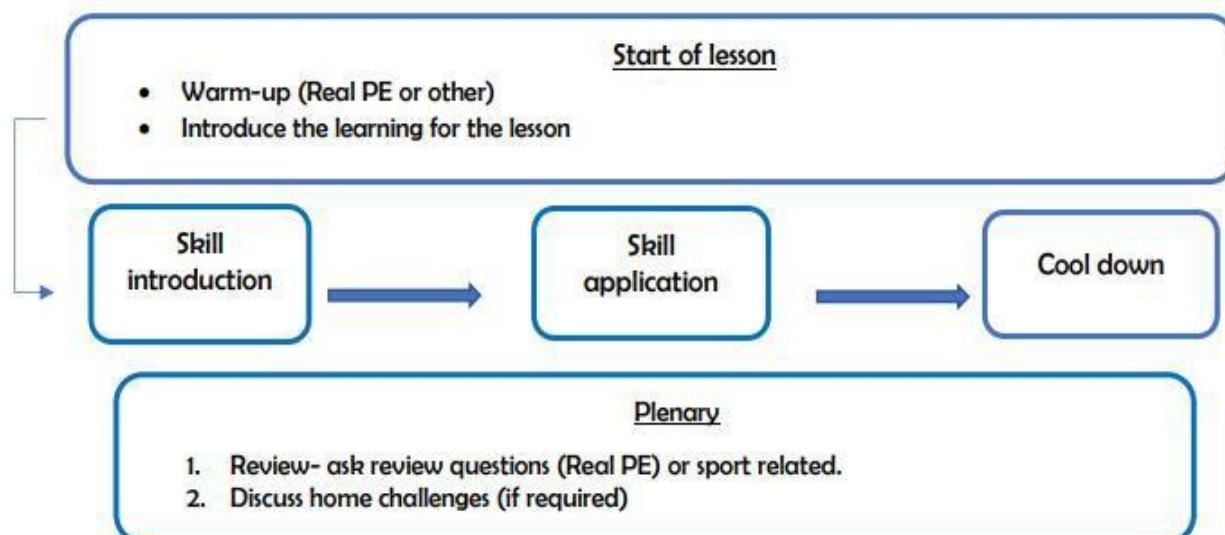

School Games Mark. • Opportunities to take part in inter schools sport related activities (football tournament, cricket tournament, athletics). • After school club opportunities. • Physical literacy sessions
Assessment: • Review of previous learning • Children recorded as working towards, expected or exceeding against the outcomes • Additional notes made of any key information if appropriate • Opportunities for self-assessment and peer assessment when performing skills • End of unit assessments- benchmarked using Real PE and teacher assessment from sports related sessions.	All children will succeed through our small steps approach: • Clear objectives shared with the children • Key vocabulary shared with children within lessons • High quality demonstrations of skills provided by staff and/or pupils • High quality equipment selected to support children with their skill development • Talking Partners used to support with self and peer observations • Opportunities to demonstrate understanding through performance • Competition with themselves and others • Following of the School Games Values: Teamwork, honesty, self-belief, determination, passion and respect
