Dear Families,

Re: Y5/6 Residential to White Hall - 6th to 8th of July 2026.

We are delighted to inform you that we are planning a three-day (two-night) residential visit to White Hall in Buxton from the 6th to the 8th of July 2026. This exciting opportunity is open to all children in Years 5 and 6.

This trip provides an amazing chance for the children to enjoy adventurous outdoor activities, build confidence, and develop new skills in a supportive environment. The experiences on offer are not only great fun, but they also play an important role in developing independence, teamwork, cooperation, and trust. All activities are led by experienced and qualified instructors. The accommodation is self-contained, and children will enjoy a variety of healthy and filling meal options to keep them energised after a busy day of activities. Further details about the specific activities and a full itinerary will be shared closer to the time.

The total cost of the residential is **£270.00** per child, which includes all accommodation, meals, instructor fees, insurance and transport. Full payment is due by **Friday 12th June 2026**.

To reserve your child's place, a £50 deposit must be paid via ParentPay by **Friday 6th February 2026**. The remaining balance can then be paid in instalments on 13th March, 10th April, 8th May, and 12th June 2026.

Please note that places are limited to 36 children, and will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis once deposits have been received. In addition, we must have at least 20 pupils signed up in order for the trip to go ahead. If the trip does not go ahead, deposits will of course be refunded.

Children will need to bring a packed lunch on the first day of the trip. If your child is entitled to free school meals and you would like the school to provide a basic packed lunch, please inform the school office by **Friday 12th June 2026**.

We would also like to remind families that participation in the trip depends on children demonstrating good behaviour and a positive attitude in school. This helps ensure that the trip is safe and enjoyable for everyone.
